During this special season of Thanksgiving, I want to take a moment to express my thanks for the opportunity to serve on the GEM staff with the wonderful team of teachers and support staff God has placed in this ministry. It is our privilege to partner with each of you teaching and nurturing your precious children. I am blessed to work in a job I truly love!

Thank you to each parent who was able to attend Open House. We appreciate your time and value the relationships we can build in order to partner most effectively with you teaching and nurturing your children. Thanks to all the families who contributed items and gift cards for the class baskets that were auctioned off at Open House. Thanks also to everyone who bid on items and won! It was great to visit with families at Open House and provide families with an opportunity to visit classrooms and interact with GEM staff. The total raised from the auction is \$11,712. These funds will go towards an additional outdoor play area and/or expanding our supplies and resources for our students and staff. Thanks so much for your support!

One of our goals is to encourage our students to develop hearts of gratitude and thankfulness for all God has given us. Every class enjoys at least 25 minutes of daily outdoor play. Childcare licensing recognizes the importance of regularly planned large motor activities throughout the school day; and as a licensed childcare center we adhere to their standards. In addition to playground time, all students participate in P.E. and Music & Movement for at least 20 minutes per school week as well as daily music and movement activities utilized during circle time and class transitions. In all, students have opportunities to engage in large motor activities added to their schedule. Outdoor play extends opportunities for large muscle development, social-emotional development, and small muscle development by offering variety, challenge, and complexity in ways that are not attainable in confined indoor space.
